### Gift Aid

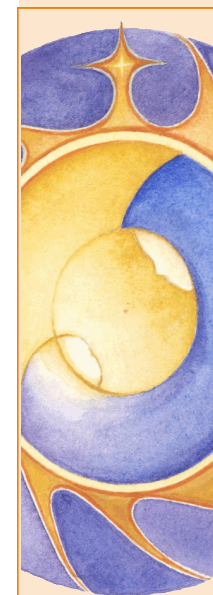
