Coronavirus Church Guidance Update

Before you arrive

You should stay at home if you are unwell. Remember the Sunday obligation has not been reinstated and live-streaming of Masses will continue.

You will need to bring your own face covering. All people entering church must wear a face covering at all times.

You should avoid bringing any unnecessary items into church, e.g. shopping bags, as you will not be returning to your seat after you have received Holy Communion.

When you arrive

You will be welcomed by a volunteer steward and you will be asked give contact details if you do not have Track and Trace.

You will be directed to the hand sanitiser.

You will be directed to a bench. It may not be where you usually sit.

You must adhere to social distancing guidelines in place.

Toilets will remain closed at all times, except for a genuine emergency

The Piety Stall will be closed.

After Mass

Please take home any newsletters, Mass sheets and other papers you may use.

Use only the designated exit.

<u>Strictly no gathering</u> in the church porch or on church property for conversations.

Continue to wear your fact covering until you leave the area where other people are.

Whilst we will attempt to take appropriate precautions consistent with the advice of public health authorities, parishioners should understand that they assume the risk of contracting COVID-19 any time they enter a public space since such precautions do not eliminate the risk of infection.

Polite Notice

Everyone who enters the church for mass/funerals/baptism etc must wear a mask or visor. Our Volunteer stewards who are following government guidelines should not be subjected to abuse when approaching someone who is not wearing a mask and following the rules that have been set out. Thank you.
