### Missionary Society of St. Columban Mission Appeal 2022

This weekend we warmly welcome Fr. John Boles who will be celebrating our three weekend masses, as Father Colin is on holiday. He will be making an appeal for the Columban Fathers.

Father John comes from Stockport and prior to ordination enjoyed a career as a Town Planner. Most of his priestly life has been spent in Latin America, most notably some 27 years in Peru. He returned to Britain last year to take up the post of Local Superior.

Regarding the Columban Fathers, they were founded in 1918 as the "Maynooth Mission to China". They changed their name and began working in other countries around the Pacific Rim once Mao expelled all foreign missionaries in 1952.

### How We Help Diverse Challenges, Sustainable Change

Our work addresses diverse global challenges. Columbans are internationally recognized for their efforts on issues as broad as the threat of climate change, migrant rights and economic justice. But what connects it all is a core belief in human dignity and what it takes to restore it. Truly helping those who are exploited or marginalized can only come from living their experience. Because Columbans commit to their communities—often for years—people feel real, sustained change, not just temporary relief.

## Saints of the Day

**28th June - St Irenaeus** . A bishop and martyr (c.130-200) was of Eastern origin, perhaps from Smyrna whose bishop Polycarp, disciple of John the Apostle, he had known as a boy. He studied at Rome and became a priest at Lyons; later becoming a bishop after the previous bishop was martyred. Irenaeus proved himself to be an important theologian. His significance, however, was only fully realized in the 20th century. Irenaeus strongly emphasized the importance of Tradition in the apostolic succession of the episcopate and in formation of the Canon of Scripture, where authority of the Four Gospels, completing each other, is supreme.

**29th June Ss Peter and Paul.** It is a holy day of obligation in large parts of the Latin Church. On this feast, newly created metropolitan archbishops receive from the pope the primary symbol of their office, the pallium.

**30th June - First Martyrs of the See of Rome.** The First Martyrs of the Church of Rome were Christians martyred in the city of Rome during Nero's persecution in 64. The event is recorded by both Tacitus and Pope Clement I, among others.

**1st July - St Oliver Plunket.** 1629-1681. Born in County Meath, Ireland, Oliver studied in Rome and was ordained in 1654. Consecrated Bishop of Armagh in 1669, he began the task of restoring the Church, laid waste by continuous persecution. Arrested on a sham charge of complicity, Irish judges refused to convict him of treason because he propagated the Catholic faith. He was brought to London and on his second trial was found guilty of treason with little evidence. He was executed at Tyburn in 1681
