This is in a response to Pope Francis's 2015 encyclical Laudato Si'; to care for and protect our common home. It follows the call by Archbishop Malcolm to respond to the Ecological Crisis and the practical guidance issued to all Diocesan Departments by the Catholic Bishops Conference of England and Wales in 2019. We work on this applying the principles of Catholic Social Teaching and the methodology of See – Judge – Act.
