# Third Sunday of Lent Psalter Week 3 Year B 3rd March 2024

On the 3rd Sunday of Lent Year B, the Gospel from John 2:13-25 portrays Jesus cleansing the Jerusalem temple at Passover, an act demonstrating His zeal for God's house and rebuking its commercial misuse. Unlike the synoptic gospels, John's narrative lacks parables and emphasizes Jesus' divine nature throughout. This event, where Jesus foretells His death and resurrection through the metaphor of destroying and rebuilding the temple in three days, highlights His authority and mission. Though many came to believe in Him, Jesus' cautious approach towards human nature is evident, underscoring His divine insight and the unique perspective of John's Gospel on His ministry

Please pray this prayer with me as we journey together through Lent to the light of Easter God our Father,

Through your mercy you have called us To become your children.

Help us to walk with your Son through his passion, death and resurrection so that by the power of the Holy Spirit we may rise with him on Easter Day. Show us your mercy and love every step throughout our lives that we may grow in friendship with you, now and forever.





#### Saints of the Day

**7th March—Ss Perpetua and Felicity.** Saint Perpetua, a young mother of Carthaginian nobility, and Saint Felicity, a slave girl, were Christians. Because of their Christian faith they were thrown to wild beasts; but having remained unharmed, they were put to death by the sword. They were martyred during the persecution of Septimus Severus.

8th March -St John of God. John (1495-1550), the founder of the Brothers Hospitallers was born in Portugal. He joined mercenaries and fought for Spain against the French and the Turks. In the army he gave up the practice of religion. He left the army and worked as a shepherd. At the age of forty he was converted to a life of dedication to the service of God. In Gibraltar he became a peddler of religious books and pictures and later opened a shop in Granada. He suffered a period of apparent madness and ran through the streets giving away all his books. St John of Avilla calmed him and persuaded him to devote his energies to the poor and sick. His final illness was brought on through rescuing a drowning man in a flood. He died before the altar of his hospital chapel aged 55. After his death rules were drawn up by his followers, who took yows and became a Religious Order.

**9th March– St Frances of Rome.** Born in 1384 she is an Italian saint who was a wife, mother, mystic, organiser of charitable services and a Benedictine oblate. Frances founded a religious community of oblates, who shared a common life without religious vows. She died on March 9, 1440 in Rome.
