# 2025 Holy Year of Jubilee—Pilgrims of Hope

## & Christ the King Parish Centenary

To mark the Universal Year of Jubilee and the Centenary of Christ the King Parish Fr Colin hopes to lead a pilgrimage to the shrines of Italy, visiting Rome, Assisi and San Giovani. The ten day pilgrimage flying from Manchester will depart on 4th November and return on 13th November.   - Leave Assisi for San Giovani Rotondo, visit Holy House at Loreto
- San Giovanni—2 night stay: Mass, talk about Padre Pio at English Office, Guided visit of Basilica
- Travel to Pietrelcina, birthplace of Padre Pio for Mass and then continue journey to Naples for final overnight stay

### Saints of the Day

**26th January—Saints Timothy & Titus**, *Bishops* C1 Timothy and Titus were disciples and helpers of the apostle Paul, the former being placed in charge of the Church at Ephesus, the latter the Church at Crete. St Paul wrote his pastoral epistles to them containing much useful advice for the instruction of the clergy and people.

**27th January—St Angela Merici,** *Virgin* 1474-1540 Born at Densenzano near Brescia, Angela took the habit of the Third Order of St Francis and gathered together girls whom she formed in the works of charity. In 1535 she formed at Brescia the religious institute of the Ursulines, a society of women with the task of teaching poor girls to be good Christians.

**28th January**— **St Thomas Aquinas,** *Priest and Doctor of the Church* c1225-1274 A member of a noble family of Aquino. He studied first at Monte Cassino and then at Naples; later as a member of the Dominican Order he completed his studies at Paris and then at Cologne with St Albert the Great as his teacher. He was an outstanding writer and teacher of philosophy and sacred theology. He died at Fossanuova on 17th March 1274. He is venerated on 28th January, for on that date in the year 1369 his body was reburied at Toulouse.

#### 31st January—St John Bosco, Priest 1815—1888

Born near Castelnuovo in the diocese of Turin, he had a difficult childhood in poverty, but eventually was ordained priest. He put every effort into the education of youth and founded religious congregations to teach them and bring them up in the Christian way of life. He also wrote some short works in defence of the faith.
